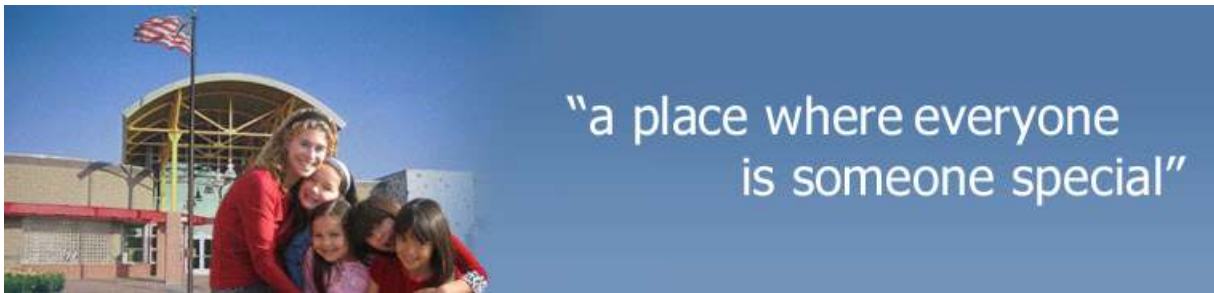

Dear Anza Families:

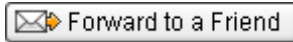
